Since 1987 many lives have been changed because of the encouragement, motivation, care and support they have received from the wonderful staff and volunteers at Tailem Bend Community Centre.

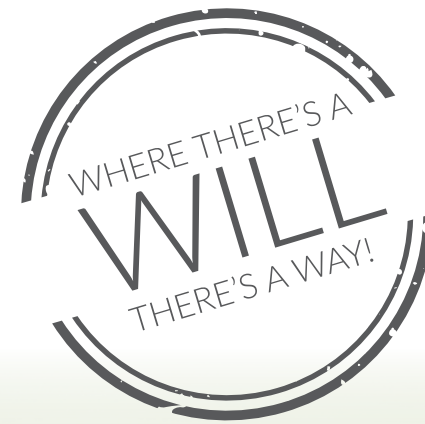
Like many struggling organisations, the Tailem Bend Community Centre is dependent on grants and donations to fund its services to the community.
