



Code of Conduct for participation in our Centre

The Centre Participants Code of Conduct policy has been developed to:

- Protect the rights of all Tailem Bend Community Centre (TBCC) participants.
- Provide clear guidelines for appropriate behavior in our Centre.
- Encourage Centre participants to make positive changes when their behavior is inappropriate.

Every participant in activities and programs has the right to:

- **Feel safe**
- **Be treated with respect**
- **A harassment free environment**
- **An environment free of abusive language or behavior**
- **An environment that is respectful and tolerant of diverse beliefs and views**
- **Be treated fairly and with decency**
- **Have confidential information respected**
- **A smoke, alcohol and drug free environment**
- **Information about the services and programs offered**
- **Information about their rights and responsibilities**

Any person who breaches the above code of conduct may be asked to leave the Centre.

For a serious or subsequent breach, exclusion from the Centre for a determined time will occur.
