About 12 ladies and 1 gentleman have joined the sessions each Tuesday at the RSL Hall, from 3.30 to 4.30pm. The classes are funded under the Commonwealth Home and Community Care (HACC) program, people over 65 years of age, those on a disability pension or caring for someone can join. Classes cost \$5.50 per session. What is Tai Chi? It had it's origins in Martial Arts exercises but now-adays the emphasis is on the exercises to keep flexible, keep our Brain fully functioning, and keep our sense of balance – all growing challenges as we enter our "Dessert" years. (After our Entree years of School Sports and our Main Course years of Mum's Taxi, unpaid Farm Hand, etc. our Dessert years are OUR time)!
